

**Cheyenne HPA CN-3**  
**November 3, 2008 Meeting**  
**Participant Comments (C) / Questions (Q) and District Responses (R)**

**Q: Is GMD 4 considering amount restrictions based on crop irrigated as a possible solution?**

R: We're not considering anything at this time. This suggestion or approach can be done if desired, or not, if opposed. Participation recommendations to the board will carry much weight.

**Q: What is the district considering a "crisis level"?**

R: We're not considering anything at this time. Whatever the participants consider a "crisis level" will likely define the "crisis level".

**C: There are weaker wells South of this designated HPA township. They should have been included.**

R: The sections they are in did not trigger either of the pre-set triggers.

**C: Several scenarios – both hydrologic and economic – need to be run to see projections on future well yields.**

R: This is a stakeholder position which will be provided to the board and which appears to be consistent with the HPA process and current statutes and regulations.

**C: Everyone needs to be involved (entire GMD) – not just the HPA people**

R: This is a stakeholder position which will be provided to the board but does not appear to be consistent with the HPA process.

**C: The HPA needs to be expanded to the East, West and South to cover adjacent wells.**

R: The adjacent sections did not trigger either of the pre-set triggers. Will pass comment on to board.

**C: Doing nothing is not an option. Something needs to be done.**

R: This is a stakeholder position which will be provided to the board and which appears to be consistent with the HPA process and current statutes and regulations.

**Q: What observation wells are in Township 5-39 just East of this HPA?**

R: There are 3 such wells shown in the West 2/3 of Township 5-39, but the only mapping we have with us doesn't show the entire Township 5-39.

**C: Want to continue discussions with a subsequent meeting when more producers can be present.**

R: District will work with the board to set another meeting later this winter for this HPA, and sufficiently advertise to get the word out.
