APPLICATION FOR TERM PERMIT TO ESTABLISH A MULTI-YEAR FLEX ACCOUNT

We are pleased that you are considering the use of a Multi-Year Flex Account to assist in your water management planning. Flex accounts offer a new tool to assist in crop planning and water management. We understand that the best crop and water use decisions are made in the field, at the local level.

The concept behind Multi-Year Flex Accounts is that water management and improved conservation is best left to you - the owner / operator. Flex accounts give you five years of flexible water planning. At the conclusion of the five years, you may return to normal use, with no change in your base water right. If the flex account tool is useful to you, you can continue with the program for an additional five-year term by filing for another flex account when this term has expired.

Please note, that as a water right owner operator, you have basic requirements under state laws. You also have responsibilities to manage this valuable water asset. A list of laws, regulations and suggested management practices for your consideration are included with this application as "Attachment A"

That as the owner, or a duly authorized agent of the owner, by signing below, I understand that if this application is approved, a term permit will be issued for a period of not more nor less than five (5) consecutive calendar years and that this term permit will suspend the appropriation of water under the Certificate of Appropriation for Beneficial Use of Water or the Vested Right that is used as the basis for this Multi-Year Flex Account for the effective period of the Flex Account. The Term Permit is subject to state law and applicable rules and regulations including any applicable groundwater management district regulations. See Attachment A.

As landowner/agent pursuant to this application, I agree to supply upon request any additional documentation necessary to support the review of this application. I understand that failure to provide all necessary documentation in support of this proposed Multi-Year Flex Account will result in the dismissal of the application. Further, I understand that such dismissal will result in the loss of the application filing fee, but shall not limit the applicant's standing to file subsequent Multi-Year Flex Account Applications for Term Permit on this base water right or other base water rights.

The undersigned declares that as owner of the authorized place of use as identified herein, or representative of the same, I am authorized to make this application in his or her behalf, and declare further that the information provided herein is true, correct, and complete to the best of my knowledge.

By signing, I acknowledge that during the period authorized pursuant to the Multi-Year Flex Account, all conditions are binding upon all owners, heirs or assignees.

NOTE: The application must be signed by each owner of the authorized place(s) of use covered by the water right. If married, the spouse must also sign. Please indicate if there is no spouse. If land is being purchased under contract, the seller must sign as landowner until such time as the contract is completed.

In the event that all applicants cannot appear before one notary public, they may as necessary sign separate copies of the application before any notary public conveniently available to them. All copies signed in this manner shall be considered to be valid parts of the application.

If the request is signed on behalf of any owner by someone with legal authority to do so (for example, an agent, one who has power of attorney, or an executor, executrix, conservator), it will be necessary to attach proper documents showing such authority.

Attachment A

Landowners/Operators are the critical component in the success of Multi-Year Flex Accounts and, in fact, to all water rights administration. Good records and measurement are keys to insuring that all water users are able to maximize use, while, to the extent possible, conserving this natural resource. The legal requirements for a Multi-Year Flex Account mirror the requirements for any water right.

The following are requirements or suggestions provided for your consideration:

Requirements: The Multi-Year Flex Account is based upon an existing water right. The base Water Right(s) is, in effect, suspended during the term of the Flex Account, and may be exercised only under the specific conditions described in K.A.R. 5-16-7. However, once the Flex Account term ends, the base water right resumes, unless the right is placed in another Flex Account or other special program;

- A. Except as noted below in paragraph C., the applicant will ensure there is a properly installed water flowmeter on the approved diversion works prior to the actual first use of water which meets all of the current specifications described in K.A.R. 5-1-4 through 5-1-12;
- B. That the applicant agrees to allow the inspection of the flowmeter installed to measure water use;
- C. If the flowmeter was properly installed prior to current specifications, Division of Water Resources (DWR) may grant an exception from current specifications if the meter flow tests accurately. An inaccurate meter will require a meter installation that meets current specifications;
- D. That the applicant agrees to report any and all instances which result in a water flowmeter malfunction on the next business day following the discovery of said malfunction;
- E. That the applicant agrees to repair or replace said flowmeter within 15 days of the discovery of any malfunction or within any authorized extension of time needed to complete the repairs. The replacement of said flowmeter will result in the new flowmeter meeting current specifications:
- F. That the applicant agrees to notify the Division of Water Resources in writing on a form prescribed by the Chief Engineer of the water flowmeter installation and any water flowmeter repair or replacement event;
- G. That the applicant agrees to maintain a record of the quantity diverted under the approval of this Multi-Year Flex Account at the first of each month of the period of authorization. Further, the applicant agrees to make such information available upon request by the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, Chief Engineer or his/her authorized representative;
- H. The place of use or use made of water authorized pursuant to the proposed Multi-Year Flex Account shall not be changed during the period of the Multi-Year Flex Account;
- I. Any change in the point of diversion will be based on a change to the base water right;
- J. The Multi-Year Flex Account, just like the base water right, remains subject to any and all Orders of the Chief Engineer, which includes but is not limited to: Minimum Desirable Streamflow; Intensive Groundwater Use Control Areas, Local Enhanced Management Areas, and/or orders related to impairment of a senior water right;
- K. Failure to comply with the above referenced stipulations and conditions may result in revocation of the Multi-Year Flex Account permit, and imposition of penalties as provided in K.A.R. 5-14-10:

Suggested practices:

Backup measurements; The owner is strongly encouraged to install and keep records from a backup flowmeter or alternate measurement device, such as an hour-meter or other newer technology. In the event that your water flowmeter is broken or found to be inaccurate, the backup measurements may allow DWR to determine the amount of water used while accurate water flowmeter records are not available. If alternative records to establish water use were not available, DWR will be required to make basic assumptions on water use during the period. This may include assigning 150% of the maximum annual quantity of the base water right to that year. We would prefer to have back up data that reflects the water you actually used. If you have questions about appropriate backup sources, please contact your local GMD, DWR or any private meter resource.

More on meters:

Sealing meters; Most water rights holders are conscientious stewards of water, understanding and appreciating its value and using it according to rules and regulations. Unfortunately, not everyone follows the rules. A few use dishonest practices that allow them to overuse water to the detriment of their neighbors. DWR and the GMD's have determined that a program that "seals" a meter, upon its being found to be accurate and/or is fully in compliance with current specifications, ensures that everyone is "playing by the rules" and maximizes the value of water use.

Here is how the sealing works:

- a. The water flowmeter and the measuring chamber are sealed to the diversion works in a manner to ensure the flowmeter and the measuring chamber may not be removed and reinstalled without breaking the seal.
- b. In addition, the water flowmeter register is sealed in a manner to ensure that the register may not be manipulated without breaking the seal:
- Once a meter is sealed, DWR must be notified and authorize breaking any seal;

Anti-Reverse Mechanisms provide additional assurance that the metered quantity is reliable. We require that any water flowmeter replaced during the duration of the Multi-Year Flex Account be upgraded or replaced with anti-reverse flow mechanisms;
