

**Sherman HPA SH-2
January 29, 2009 Meeting
Participant Comments (C) / Questions (Q) and District Responses (R)**

Q: Will the HPA boundaries always remain or might they change over time?

R: The HPA protocol process is reiterative. As such, it is possible for the boundaries to change, or HPAs to be eliminated, or new HPA areas added.

Correction: While the HPA process is reiterative, those established HPAs utilizing WTAP funds must be retained as these areas must remain formally and permanently closed to new appropriations.

C: Meet again when models are ready.

R: Agreed.

C: The next meeting should be coordinated with the Sherman County Board members who should get with local stakeholders to arrange the next meeting,
